



XXXX will do the following chores:

1. Clean the bathroom on Tuesday and Saturday BEFORE leaving the house, or by noon.
 - a. Tuesday: All mirrors, the sink, and the toilet should have all foreign objects (lint, hair, dust, etc.) wiped off and thrown away.
 - b. Saturday: Same as Tuesday, but also scrub the tub so there is no dirt or residue, and vacuum the floor.

2. Keep his part of his room clean
 - a. Daily: Put ALL clothes, garbage, food, dishes, paper, and other clutter where it belongs BEFORE leaving the house or by noon.
 - b. Saturday: In addition to the daily cleaning, XXXX will vacuum the whole bedroom.

3. If XXXX wants to wash his own clothes, using Mom's machines, he must have either ____ or ____ watch him use the machines. If XXXX uses the machines without supervision, he must take all responsibility to wash his clothes at the laundromat for one month.

Reward

1. For every day XXXX completes his chores he will be allowed to:
 - Leave the house for work or other approved outings
 - Keep his cell phone
 - Use Mom's computer, if Mom approves.
2. If XXXX completes his chores from today until July 17, and he proves he knows how to use the laundry machines correctly, he will then be allowed to wash his own clothes with Mom's machines one time per week. Any abuse of the machines will result in loss of this privilege.

Consequences

1. If XXXX does not comply with rule 1 and 2 he must surrender his cell phone for 24 hours. He will not argue about this, and no excuses regarding the whereabouts of the phone will be accepted.
2. If XXXX does not have the phone in his possession, he will spend all hours he is not at work in his room for the next 24 hours.
3. If XXXX refuses this consequence, Mom will call his probation office and notify him/her of the situation and request assistance.
